

SACAR Celebrates its Anniversary - February 29, 2008





Golden Day, 29th February 2008 marked the "second" leap anniversary of SACAR. A small celebration was held at SACAR premises to mark this occasion. The event also marked the inauguration of the newly constructed Scholars' Home at SACAR. More than 50 people came for the programme, and Tara-Di from Delhi Branch of Sri Aurobindo Ashram did the honour of lighting the ceremonial lamp. Later the attendees had a rare opportunity to hear from Tara-Di and Lata-Di about their experiences of growing up with the Mother. Following its tradition of the past several years, this year also special events were organized at SACAR around February Darshan. Talks by Ananda Reddy covered selected chapters from *Essays on the Gita* and *The Life Divine*, and were held during February 15-28, 2008. A few key topics of discussion included: comparison between Sankhya, Yoga of the Gita, and Yoga of Sri Aurobindo; and Relation between Man, God and Nature in Integral Philosophy.
