Memories from *The Life Divine* talks at SACAR during February Darshan













News from Hyderabad

The Institute of Human Study (IHS) has published a new book by Dr. Prasanna Krishna, titled "Sri Aravindula Chintanamrutham." It was released by Prof. Suprasannecharya in a special function held on February 21, 2010.

The performance at Ravindra Bharathi on April 11, 2010 involved about 40 students from Sri Aurobindo International School who performed the roles of different characters in the play. Shri B. Venkatesham (Managing Director, Andhra Pradesh Tourism Development), Prof. Emeritus Sivaramakrishna. Prof. Sachidananda Mohanty, Dr. Sivakumar (Scientist) and Shri K. Venkateshwara Rao participated in celebrations and gave inspirational messages. The performance was attended by about 1200 people.
